(FTE: £26,000 to £28,000 dependant on experience)





URGENT REQUEST - SWEP (Severe Weather Emergency Protocol)

Can you be on a pool of volunteers ready to assist at a local hall in Bexley for the SWEP, if it is repeated this year, to house homeless people on extremely cold nights?

These roles are best suited for people who have worked in the Emergency Services or worked/volunteered with individuals who are Homeless.

There are 2 main roles needed to be filled:

# 1. Setting up

8.00pm-10pm – Setting up the venue, making beds, getting refreshments ready, ensuring the space is warm and providing hot drinks for the homeless when they arrive

# 2. Overnight Watcher

10pm-Morning — Staying awake all night to take any incoming calls, receiving new homeless people, providing hot drinks for any new arrivals, keeping other volunteers company and making breakfast for residents in the morning.

The project is co-ordinated by BWS. If enough volunteers aren't available, overnight opening is not possible. Please do share with anyone with whom you feel this would be relevant, and contact BWS via
